RING SIZE GUIDE

Measure your finger to find your ring size

Print this document on A4 paper. Ensure the 'Fit to page/printable area' is not chosen in your print selection.

Cut around the sizer image and a slot as indicated

Wrap the sizer around your finger and pull the end through the slot you have cut into the sizer

Pull the end so that it fits around your finger then read the letter that the arrow is pointing to; this indicates your ring size

Idealy, the sizer should be able to slide over your knuckle comfortably. If too tightly pulled, a wrong size may be indicated.



Measure a ring you already own

Choose a ring you already own and place it over the sizing circles until you find a circle that aligns with the inside edge of your ring
